An excursion has been planned for Yr 11 and 12 students on Tuesday 25th and Wednesday 26th June and has been approved by the Principal. The purpose of the excursion is to allow students to investigate study options at Charles Sturt University (Albury) by attending the Explore CSU event **OR** to explore TAFE study options at Riverina Institute (Albury) and Wodonga TAFE.

Study areas highlighted on the MyDay: Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech and Language Pathology, Podiatric Medicine, Health and Rehabilitation Science, Accounting, Business, Environmental Science and Outdoor Recreation, Information Technology, Nursing, Teaching and Education. - Students will travel by Purtills bus. CSU have subsidised the cost of the bus.
- Cost per student will be \$45 including accommodation at the Big 4 Lavington on Tuesday Night and a movie ticket. Meals and snacks will be at the student's expense.
- Students will depart from Deniliquin High School at 3.20pm on Tuesday 25th June
- Anticipated time of arrival back at school is 5.30pm on Wednesday 26th June
- Students will be accompanied by Deniliquin High staff members who have been trained in Emergency Care.
- **Students can wear casual clothes appropriate for a visit to a tertiary institution but must wear covered shoes.**
- Any student who is in possession of, or uses, any illegal substance will be returned to school at parental expense.
